BEACON HILL Literacy Read-a-Thon

We are excited to once again hold our **BHES Literacy Read-a-Thon**. We will not be taking pledges or money this year, but all of our students will be expected to participate in the home-reading component with their families. Students will be eligible to have their name drawn for a variety of PRIZES throughout the event.

Here's how it works:

- 1). Teachers will help individual students to set a **Realistic Weekly Home-Reading Goal**. A student's reading goal will involve a specified length of time that they are expected to read (or equivalent) each week. Goal setting will look quite different from grade to grade. All forms of reading will count. Reading includes, but is <u>not</u> limited to: letter recognition practice, making and recognizing sounds, blending practice, sight word practice, reading of any genre, listening to reading, discussing and reflecting on their reading and writing about what they have read.
- 2). Weekly Home-Reading: On April 1, 2024, your child will begin reading and continue to read for the month of April (April 1 April 30). You and your child will record their weekly reading. To do this you will use the Reading Log, which is provided as part of the package. Parents/Guardians can verify each week's reading by initialing or signing on the corresponding line.
- 3). Home-Reading Logs are to be returned to the School (homeroom teacher) each week on Monday. The final date to return Week 4 is Thursday, May 2. Students will be eligible to win prizes based on the reading that they have completed.
- 4). **Prizes:** Random winners for prizes will be drawn on a weekly basis and awarded to participating students only. Homeroom teachers will develop a mechanism to determine whether students are reading. This mechanism will vary from class to class. The weekly prizes and the prizes awarded at the end of the Read-a-thon will be claimed at the office. Enjoy your reading goals!
