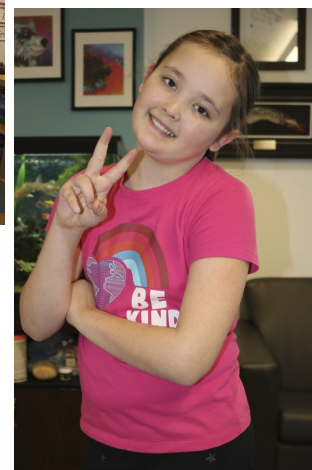

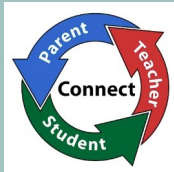
To join the meeting, use the link provided under the 'Parent Council' tab on the website.

## BEACON HILL Literacy Read-a-Thon

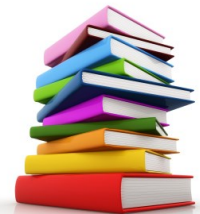
We are excited to once again hold our **BHES Literacy Read-a-Thon**. This year, we will not be taking pledges or money! All of our students will be expected to participate in the reading component of the event.

### Here's how it works:

1. Teachers will help individual students to set a **Realistic Daily Reading Goal** for the Literacy Read-a-Thon. Student goals will include reading/literacy practice and a specified length of time that they are expected to read. Goal setting will look quite different from grade to grade. All forms of reading will count. This will include, but not be limited to: letter recognition practice, sounds and blends practice, sight words practice, reading, listening to reading, discussing and reflecting on their reading and writing about what they have read.

2. **Daily Home Reading:** On **April 1, 2024**, your child will begin reading and continue to read for the month of April (**April 1 - April 30**). You and your child will record their daily reading. To do this, you will use a **Reading Log**, which is provided as part of the package that will come home later this month. Parents/Guardians can verify each day's reading by initialing or signing on the corresponding line.

3. **Home-Reading Logs** are to be returned to the School (homeroom teacher) on Thursday, May 2. The more reading, the better! Enjoy the month of connectedness as you spend time reading!



Please be advised that there is **NO** playground supervision **before 8:20am or after 3:20pm.** Students are expected to go home after school before going to the playground.
